 - b.i) Between 0 and 10 for bachelor's degrees in business administration (ADE) and related fields (PCEOS).
 - b.ii) Average grade multiplied by 0.7 for Tourism or Tourism-Geography and History.
- c) Certified Language Skills:
 - c.i) B2: 2 points; C1 or higher: 4 points.

- c.ii) German: B1: 1 point; B2: 2 points; C1 or higher: 4 points.
- d) Be enrolled in English-taught subjects: 0.5 points per approved subject.
- e) The final score of the candidate will be the sum of the points obtained in sections a), b), c) and d).
